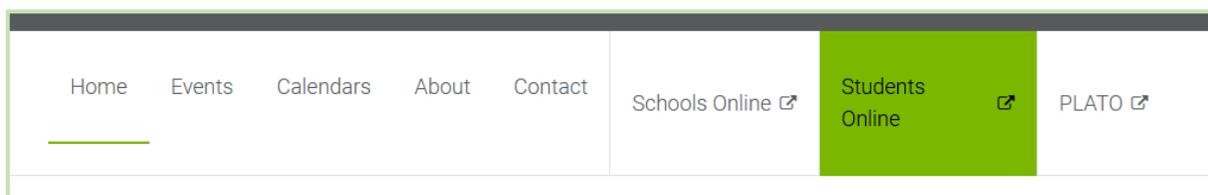
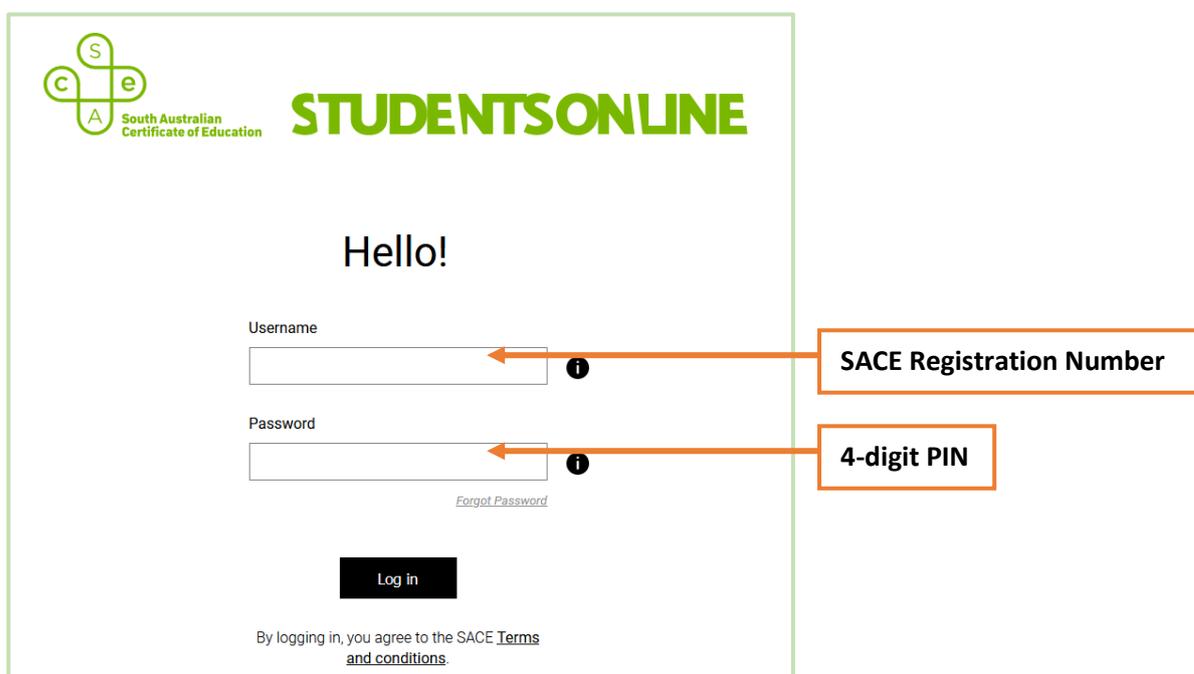


Accessing your SACE planner on Students Online

1. Go to www.sace.sa.edu.au, and click on the Students Online link on the top menu.



2. On the log-in page, enter your SACE registration number and PIN.
 - Your registration number is six digits and a capital letter (eg. 123456A). If you don't know your number, you can contact your school (if you are currently enrolled) or the SACE board on 8115 4700 (if you are not enrolled at a school).
 - If you have not logged in to Students Online before, your PIN will be your date of birth, written as DDMM (eg. 31 July will be 3107).
 - If you have forgotten your password, use the link just below the password box to reset it.

3. If you are logging on for the first time, you will be prompted to activate your account; enter your personal email address. The SACE board will send you an email link to access the system, and then set up your own password and security questions.
4. If you're currently at school, you may be prompted to update your sharing preferences. This lets the SACE board know whom they can share your results with.
 - Set your preferences for school and SATAC to Y (yes); SATAC will need your results to calculate your ATAR score for University Entrance.
 - Sharing preference for the media is up to you; your results will only be shared by the SACE board if you receive outstanding results.
5. Once you have logged into Students Online, you will be taken to the home page; click on the **SACE Planner** button.



6. On the **SACE Planner** screen, you can view credits that you have earned towards your SACE completion, as well as potential credits from subjects you may be currently enrolled in.
- To print or save a PDF copy of this page, click on the **Print** button on the right side of the screen.
